Weekly Dry Season Situation Report for the Mekong River Basin

Prepared at: 02/03/2015, covering the week from the 23rd February to 02nd March2015.

Weather Patterns, General Behaviour of the Mekong River and Dry Season Situation

General weather patterns:

No critical weather during last week

General behaviour of the Mekong River:

Compared to the long term average (LTA) the water levels from Chiang Saen to Kompong Cham decreased above the LTA, except Vientiane, Nong Khai and Kompong Cham about the LTA; from Chaktomuk to Prek Kdam decreased and remain below the LTA; water levels at Tan Chau and Chau Doc increased above the LTA.

For stations from Chiang Saen and Luang Prabang

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were decreasing above the LTA.

For stations from Chiang Khan, Vientiane and Nong Khai and Paksane

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were decreasing above the LTA, except Vientiane and Nong Khai were about the LTA.

For stations from Nakhon Phanom to Pakse

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were decreasing above the LTA.

For stations from Stung Treng to Kampong Cham

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were decreasing above the LTA except Kampong Cham that was about the LTA.

For stations from Phnom Penh to Prek Kdam

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were decreasing below the LTA.

Tan Chau and Chau Doc

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were increasing above the LTA at the end of the week.

Dry season situation

Water levels at all forecast stations of the Mekong River during the last week were normal. Some rainfalls happened in the middle reach of LMB, the maximum of 55.50 mm was observed earlier last week at Mukdahan (see Table A2).








This Annex has the water level graphs of the report date. These graphs are distributed weekly by email together with the River Monitoring Bulletin.
