Weekly Dry Season Situation Report for the Mekong River Basin

Prepared at: 07/11/2016, covering the week from the 01st to 07th November 2016.

Weather Patterns, General Behaviour of the Mekong River and Dry Season Situation

General weather patterns:

No critical weather during last week

General behaviour of the Mekong River:

Compared to the long term average (LTA) the water levels were fluctuated below the LTA, except at Chiang Saen, Pakse to Kratie that were about/above the LTA.

For stations from Chiang Saen and Luang Prabang

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at Chiang Saen and Luang Prabang stations were fluctuated above and below the LTA respectively.

For stations from Chiang Khan, Vientiane and Nong Khai and Paksane

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were fluctuated below the LTA.

For stations from Nakhon Phanom to Pakse

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were fluctuated below the LTA, except Pakse station that was above the LTA.

For stations from Stung Treng to Kompong Cham

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were fluctuated below the LTA, except at Stung Treng and Kratie that were about/above the LTA.

For stations from Phnom Penh to Prek Kdam

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were fluctuated below the LTA.

Tan Chau and Chau Doc

Compared to long term average (LTA), during last week the water levels at these stations were fluctuating below the LTA.

Dry season situation

During last week, all water levels in the LMB fluctuated below the long term average (LTA), except Chiang Saen, Pakse to Kratie that were about/above the LTA. Some heavy rainfalls happened in the lower part of LMB, and the accumulated weekly rainfall about or greater than 100 mm happened at Stung Treng (115 mm.), Koh Khel (209.8 mm.) and Neak Luong (166.6 mm.), (see Table A2).
